- **Senior (Tenure-Track) Assistant Professor** is for three years. Subject to evaluation, the position will be converted in a tenured Associate Professorship. Applicants for this position must have at least three years of experience after PhD completion, and an already established research record.

- **Associate/Full Professor** is a tenured position. Applicants should have an established track-record of publications in top international journals and evidence of leadership and recognition in the international academic community, including grant application and project management. Standards of excellence in teaching are also expected.

All positions will start in 2019. Salaries and teaching loads are competitive with other academic institutions abroad. Knowledge of Italian is not required.
