The **Master of Science in Economics** (LM-56) is a two year full-time program, taught entirely in English.

It is a program of scientific excellence, and offers training for a career as professional economist in government, central banking, international organizations or private sector firms such as economic consultancies. The advanced and quantitative nature of the program also serves as an excellent foundation for PhD programs and other research-focused roles.

Admission

Applicants must hold a three-year degree (or be near completion) in Economics, Business, Management, Physics, Statistics or Engineering.

Required Documents in English:

Transcripts of bachelor exams, CV and Motivational letter. Reference letter by a Professor or an Employer, English Language Certificate and GRE test are recommended.
