Is very important for you to know about Brexit outcome and the New Student Visa Routes implemented to EU and Non-EU Students. We apologise for giving this information now, this is because they were released on the 1st of December.

All EU students now need a student Visa from 31st of December if they wish to **study for 1 academic year or more.**

Please pay attention to the financial requirements: as from 1st of December student will require the following:

If you apply under the Student route on or after 1 December 2020, the financial requirement you must meet will be:

£1,334 a month for study in London <u>£1.023 a month for study outside London (this applies to Hertfordshire)</u> The maximum amount of money you must have is the relevant sum for you multiplied by nine.

All students wishing to apply for 1 academic year need to apply for <u>https://www.gov.uk/visa-to-study-english</u>

All student wishing to apply and study for 1 semester they need to apply for <u>https://www.gov.uk/standard-visitor-visa</u> (all Non-EU need this visa in order to come and study for 1 semester – less than 6 months) At the moment EU passports/students can come and study in UK for less than 6 months without applying for a visa they need to see a border officer and get a stamp on their passport which allows them to stay for 6 months, they do not need to use the **E-GATES when they arrive** (this can change)
