


INTERNATIONALISATION

- In the QS World University Rankings Top University 2014, "Tor Vergata" is the 7th among Italian Universities and 305th in the world, gaining 15 positions since 2013.
- In the QS World University Rankings Top 50 Under 50 2014 for Universities established within the last 50 years, "Tor Vergata" is the only Italian University and is the 33rd in the world (gaining 5 positions since 2013).
- 277 bilateral agreements with European Partner Universities.
- ERASMUS+ KA1 Learning mobility for individuals (for study & for traineeship) Call for proposals 2014-2015: 900 mobility scholarships for 673 financial agreements signed.
- 200 cultural and scientific international cooperation agreements.
- The number of courses and curricular paths in English increased from 11 to 14.
- 13 specialisation courses entirely offered or providing a path in English.
- 29 visiting professors financed for at least 3 months in the academic year 2014-2015.

How to Arrive 1



Università degli Studi di Roma"Tor Vergata" can be easily reached by Underground + Bus.

The nearest Underground Line A stop is *Anagnina* (line A last stop). At *Anagnina* take bus n° 20 (express line) or bus n° 500.

From "Fiumicino" Airport

Take a taxi (approximately 50 €)

or by train from Air Terminal to *Termini* railway station
and then take Underground line A till the last stop *Anagnina*.

From "Ciampino" Airport

Take a taxi (approximately 20 €)

or by a special bus (ATRAL).

The Italian fiscal code card, officially known as Italy's Codice Fiscale, is the tax code card in Italy, similar to a Social Security Number (SSN) card in the United States or the National Insurance Number issued in the United Kingdom. The tax code in Italy is an alphanumeric code of 16 characters. The card serves to identify unambiguously individuals residing in Italy irrespective of residency status. Designed by and for the Italian tax office, it is now used for several other purposes, e.g. uniquely identifying individuals in the health system, or natural persons who act as parties in private contracts.




