The course generally takes place during the two weeks before the beginning of lectures, starting right after enrolment; ca. 20 hours per week/ 4 Credit Points. Important note: our intensive course is primarily aimed at existing A to B1 levels. Students with a level B2 in German may be asked to choose a semester-long course if they are interested in taking a German language class.
