## REPORT ON MY ERASMUS EXPERIENCE

### 1. What is your name and which program did you attend?

My name is Giulia Cesaroni and I attended the MSc Finance and Banking.

#### 2. Where and when did you go during your Erasmus program?

I spent the second year of the MSc Finance and Banking in the University of Gothenburg, doing the Double Degree program.

### 3. How did you like living there?

Living in Sweden was an amazing experience.
