

REPORT ON MY ERASMUS EXPERIENCE

1. What is your name and which program did you attend?

I attended Uniwersytet Wrocławski (Master of Science in Managerial Economics)

2. Where and when did you go during your Erasmus program?

I went to Wrocław (Poland) and I stayed there from 11th of February until 1st of July

3. How did you like living there?

Wrocław is a strategic city in the middle of the Europe, very well linked with all European spots. During my Erasmus period I lived in dormitory and I was able to meet a lot of students coming from different countries and I was able to travel around all Europe. Moreover, the city is quite small, has a very performing transport system and every week there are cultural events.

4. What about *the University*?

Wrocław University is one of the nine Universities of this city. Erasmus Coordination, Secretary and professors are very available and they help you in every situation. Moreover, the University is in the middle of the city and it offers Erasmus students lectures and attending students lessons that can be followed both.

5. What is the level of the courses? Did you find similarities to those in Tor Vergata?

I attended Erasmus lectures. The level of courses is lower than Tor Vergata University, but teachers are very prepared.

6. Is there any particular advise that you would like to give to another student who will go there in the future?

I can suggest to send emails in order to understand which lectures will start. Often the website don't put all lectures that you can attend. The problem of this University is that they require for Erasmus lectures a minimum of 10 students for each class and professors don't know if lectures will start or not. Anyway, generally, lectures start because there are a lot of Erasmus students. All Erasmus courses have 6 CFU. At least, in order to rent flat I suggest Kredka or Olowek dormitories (better Kredka). On website is written that you can have double or single room, but generally they give you double room. This room is part of block of two rooms that share bathroom and kitchen. The total amount of people that live in this block are 4. I suggest to live in dormitory because in this way you will:

- 1) have a possibility to meet a lot of people
- 2) have a lot of parties in dormitory
- 3) stay in a strategic zone of the city at 135€
