

**VITTORIO EMANUELE PARSI** is full professor of "International Relations" in the Faculty of Political and Social Sciences of Università Cattolica del Sacro Cuore of Milan since 2005, where he also teaches "Strategic Studies". He is the director of ASERI (Graduate School of Economics and International Relations) and he is lecturer at the Faculty of Economics of the Università della Svizzera Italiana (USI) in Lugano.

He has been Chair of the SGRI (Standing Group of International Relations, 2013-2020). He is a member of the Italian Society of Political Science (SISP) and a founding member of the Society for the Study of the Dissemination of Democracy (SSDD). He is a member of the LSE IDEAS Advisory Board (Center for Diplomacy and Strategy at the London School of Economics).

He is part of the Reflection and Strategic Address Group of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs. He teaches at the Training School of the Presidency of the Council of Ministers. He is columnist for "Il Messaggero".

His main research areas concern transatlantic relations, security policies in the Middle East and the Mediterranean and the relationship between politics and economics in the transformation of the global system.

He is part of the Navy Reserve with the rank of Commander, participated in Operation Mare Sicuro on board the Frigate Bergamini (2016 and 2021) and served for two shifts at the UNIFIL Headquarters, in Naqoura (2015 and 2016). He was embarked on Destroyer Caio Duilio, Frigate Bergamini and Brigantine Amerigo Vespucci.

He received the "UN Peacekeeping Medal" and the "Commemorative Cross for Peace Operations" (with bronze star). It is decorated with the "Cross with Swords *pro Merito Melitensi*" of the Sovereign Military Order of Malta.
