

The exam consists of a **written essay/summary** and an **oral presentation**.

-The essay/summary is intended as a brief description of the main points you are going to discuss in your presentation. It can be either a theoretical paper, or you can analyze a case study, or you can mix the two.

- You can present an essay/summary on your own (**max 2500 characters/5 pages**) or in small groups of max 3 people (**max 6000 characters/12 pages**)

- During the **oral presentation** the essay is summarized to the class and defended.

- **10 minutes** plus 5 min. discussion for a single presentation

- **20 minutes** plus 10 min. discussion for a group presentation

Evaluation criteria:

- Consistency with topics presented during the course

- Solidity of the theoretical framework

- Accuracy of data

- Argumentation

- Sources and references

- Originality

The essay is due on **April 15th**, by sending it to the abovementioned email address.
