Examination Guidelines

Attending students who gave a class presentation and sat the mid-term examination should take an oral examination. The weights are 20% for the presentation, 40% for the mid-term written examination, and 40% for the oral examination. The oral will involve answering questions on the topics covered in the lectures and in the course materials uploaded on DIDA.

Non-attending students will have to sit a compulsory written examination. This will last ONE HOUR and will require answering TWO QUESTIONS on the topics covered in the lecture materials uploaded on DIDA. If they have given a class presentation, this will count for 20% of the final grade and the written examination for 80% of their final grade; otherwise the written examination will count for 100% of the final grade.

All non-attending students have the option of sitting an oral examination. In this case the oral will count for 40% of the final grade, and the weight of the written examination will be reduced accordingly.
