The Warsaw Pact Organization

- **WPO – Was a collective defense signed in Warsaw, Poland, between The Soviet Union and seven other socialist republics in May 1955, during the Cold War.**



- **It was created in reaction to the integration of west Germany into the North Atlantic Treaty Organization (NATO).**

Mao Zedong



Also known as Chairman Mao, was a Chinese communist revolutionary who was the founder of the People's Republic of China

Ideologically he was a Marxist-Leninist and his theories and political views are known as Maoism.

Relationship between The Peoples Republic of China and The Warsaw Pact Organizations

- Their relationship was dependent on its alliance with the Soviet Union;**
- Sino-Soviet Pact;**
- Unstable relationship;**
- The Soviet Union unsuccessful attempted to reorient the WPO from Europe to Asia;**
