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His academic research concerns labor relations, especially the organizational and political-economic aspects of current challenges like automation, migration and labor costs.

In addition to conducting and overseeing research and policy reports, German regularly writes columns or op-ed pieces in all major Swedish newspapers. Internationally, he has been published or interviewed in The Guardian, The New York Times, The Wall Street Journal, NPR, BBC, The Economist, Süddeutsche Zeitung, La Repubblica, Social Europe, and IPG Journal, among others.

He has recently published a book on the [historic Swedish labor strike against Tesla](#), which started in October 2023 and is still ongoing.
