

EXAM RULES:

All exams, both written and oral, will cover the topics discussed in class. Students who miss a class can watch the recorded lesson on the course Teams channel.

<i>December Written Exam:</i>	
FOR STUDENTS WHO HAVE ATTENDED AT LEAST 70% OF THE CLASSES (AT LEAST 13 OUT OF 18 CLASSES).	FOR STUDENTS WHO HAVE NOT ATTENDED AT LEAST 70% OF THE CLASSES.
The written exam will include “traditional” questions (open questions or exercises to be solved using a calculator).	The written exam will include “traditional” questions (open questions or exercises to be solved using a calculator) plus one additional question on Matlab and/or Excel (for example: “Write the script to calculate...”).

P.N.1: Live participation in classes via Teams will only be allowed for students who have a valid reason (for example, students who are on Erasmus).

P.N.2: Students who provide a medical certificate for the day of the missed class will also be considered “present”.

<i>Subsequent Oral Exams (from January 2026 onwards):</i>
FOR ALL: The exam will cover the topics discussed in class. Students will be asked three questions. At least one of them will be an exercise to be completed during the exam using Excel and/or Matlab.
