

You will find on the website of the lectures the 3 decisions (listed below) (noted Exam Material 1, 2...) delivered by the three courts we have studied. One of these six decisions will be presented in the examination of 22 May. In order to prepare, you should read these decisions using the following analysis grid: What are the relevant facts? Who are the parties involved? What is the legal issue? What solution does it provide to the dispute? On what instruments does the court base its decision? Does the court use sources exogenous to the system to which it belongs? If the court raises an issue of interpretation, by what method does it resolve it? If dissenting, what is the issue?

During the examination, you will be required to analyze one of these documents by answering a question different from the ones above.
