

Sergio Lugaresi – Curriculum Vitae

Sergio Lugaresi is currently an independent consultant and Director of the Observatory on India of CeSPI (*Centro Studi di Politica Internazionale*). He has been Executive Director (ED) for Belgium, France, Italy, Portugal, Spain, and Switzerland in the Board of Directors of the Asian Development Bank (ADB), Manila (Philippines), from October 2020 to September 2023. From August 2023 has been Dean of the Board and from July 2022 Chair of the Audit and Risk Committee of the Board. As ED he has contributed to the update and review of ADB policies and governance, evaluating projects in various sectors and member countries, with particular reference to climate change, and has proactively participated in the discussion on capital adequacy of multilateral development banks and of ADB. He had the opportunity to meet and discuss with the authorities of various member countries.

Previously, he has been consultant for the Italian Banking Association (ABI) since July 2013 and Senior Adviser at Oxera Consulting since January 2018. From April 2016 he had been member (and from February 2019 Vice-President) of the Banking Stakeholder Group of the European Banking Authority. From June 2018 he had been independent Director at the Board of IGD S.i.i.q. S.p.a. He has been ad interim Head of the Rome Office of the World Bank (2014-17), Head of Regulatory Affairs at UniCredit S.p.A. (2007-2012), and Chief Economist in Capitalia and Banca di Roma (1997-2007). He had worked as manager at the Italian Statistical Office (ISTAT) and as economist at the IMF and at the Italian Institute for Economic Planning (ISPE). He took his PhD at the University of Modena. He has published several articles and papers on economic and monetary policy, fiscal policy, income redistribution.

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
