

# APPLICATION FOR FEE EXCEPTIONS AT

Shanghai Jiao Tong University Summer Programme

# A.Y. 2016/2017

## Art. 1 – Application and programmes description

For the Academic Year 2016/2017, the University of Rome Tor Vergata announces an application for fee exceptions to join the Shanghai Jiao Tong University (SJTU) Summer Programme 2017; an overseas learning experience at an internationally acclaimed research university in Shanghai, China. **Three fee exceptions** will be available for students selected upon merit.

Here follows the description of the two different programmes on offer in the summer of 2017: the Global Summer School and the Summer Research Internship.

• Global Summer School (6<sup>th</sup> - 20<sup>th</sup> July and 6<sup>th</sup> July - 3<sup>rd</sup> August)

The 2017 SJTU Global Summer School programme runs two sessions in July and August, including a twoweek session ( $6^{th} - 20^{th}$  July) that focuses on Chinese Policy, Traditional Chinese Medicine and Urban Horticulture; a four-week session ( $6^{th}$  July –  $3^{rd}$  August) that offers course in Chinese Creativity, China Studies and Brain Facts. In addition, free Chinese Language and Culture is offered as optional course to all students. Global Summer School provides international students with a unique experience of Chinese culture and history through a combination of lectures, workshops and fields trips.

• Summer Research Internship (6<sup>th</sup> July - 30<sup>th</sup> August)

The SJTU offers 46 world-class research projects for overseas undergraduate students which covers 9 fields including mechanical engineering, electronic information and electronic engineering, agriculture and pharmacy, etc. The internship lasts eight weeks. All students admitted will be waived of tuition fee and they have the chance to be awarded scholarships offered by SJTU. Students can have chance to attend in the paper-writing process and served as a co-author on one publication. Summer research internship will help you lay the foundation for career.

### Art.2 - Eligibility Criteria

Students regularly enrolled in a Bachelor or Master of Science/Art or One-cycle degree programme at the University of Rome Tor Vergata for the a.y. 2016/2017 can submit their application to this call.

#### - Exclusion

A student cannot apply for this call if he/she:

- a) Is enrolled out of time ("fuori corso") with respect to the normal duration of the course;
- b) Has received a disciplinary sanction.

#### Art.3 – Application and evaluation criteria

Applications are to be sent via e-mail to <u>summer.schools@uniroma2.it</u> by 28<sup>th</sup> January 2017. Students will be evaluated on the basis of the submitted documentation, which has to include:

- **Motivation Letter** (1 to 3 points)
- Curriculum Vitae, including GPA and exams passed (1 to 3 points)
- **English language level** (1 to 3 points, assigned on certificates held by the student and an interview)

GPA = average of passed exams (with a final mark) weighted with credits, namely sum of marks multiplied by credits divided by sum of credits (exams passed and registered within October 31st, 2015)

CREDITS OBTAINED = sum of credits obtained with passed exams including suitability exams.

#### Art. 4 – Admission Commission

An admission Commission will be nominated and will evaluate all the applications on 31<sup>st</sup> January 2017. Results will be published at <u>http://summerschool.uniroma2.it/</u>.
