

School Of Future Leaders: announcement of selection

“School of Future Leaders” is a talent program delivered by Consorzio ELIS (CONSEL <http://www.elis.org/consel>).

The program is aimed at providing leadership models through real experiences coming from top executive leading firms among those belonging to the CONSEL network.

School of Future Leader is composed of three parts which are: Boot Camp, Shadowing and Living Company.

Students taking part in the **Boot Camp** have the chance to meet top executives as managing directors which share with the participants their professional career, then managers challenge them providing a case study based on a hot issue and ask them for innovative solutions. Students, working in team, are called to answer a problem which the manager either faced or is still dealing with. Beside, once teams figure out a solution then have the opportunity to present and explain it to the manager. Case studies are mainly related to strategic choices, developing of new products and services and new technologies.

Students chosen by the manager during the Boot Camp can take part in the **Shadowing** which is a day long activity offering to the students the opportunity to live a full working day along with the top executive doing together what he usually does in order to lead his team.

The last part of the program, the **Living Company**, offers to develop a thesis straightly with a company among those belonging to our network.

The program admits a maximum of 30 students coming from the following universities: Università dell’Aquila, Bocconi, LUISS, Politecnico di Milano, Università di Pisa, Politecnico di Torino, Tor Vergata, Sapienza Università di Roma, Università degli Studi Mediterranea di Reggio Calabria and other international partners.

The next Boot Camp called **SOFL Summer Edition 2014**, will take place from August 28 through September 2 and will be held in Rome, students are not charged of any fee since the program is completely supported by our partners..

Application requirements :

- Current year of course must be either second year of a bachelor’s degree or first year of a master’s degree
- Exam average: 27 / 30
- Max age: 24
