Concept

The international week will offer the opportunity to attend courses managed by teachers coming from different universities.

Each course unit (8 hours) will be managed jointly by two instructors that have to design the course together.

Instructors for each course unit will be selected on the basis of the topic of their specialization and no teams will be created with faculty members coming from the same university.







Students

Student that will attend the course are second and third year students from the bachelor in Business Administration and Economics at Tor Vergata University of Rome.

Classes will be very small (10 students) in order to favour interactive lectures.

- Teachers are expected to organize and manage an 8 hours with a colleague and to join the final event scheduled for Friday.
- Lectures will not be scheduled on Thursday.

Teachers has the freedom to choose his own teaching method (lectures, seminars, projectbased instruction, etc...).

• For each module 10 multiple choices has to be prepared.In each class there will be no more than 10 students attending.







Topic proposal

- Faculty member has to submit a proposal for a topic
- The International week coordinator will evaluate the proposal and he will identify the instructor teams
- After the acceptance to the international week, faculty members have to meet online (jointly with the coordinator) for a first debriefing about the module structure.







Closing and award



ceremony

- On Friday during the final ceremony there will be 3 roundtables and all faculty members will be involved in one of them.
- A free shuttle service will be provided from the school of Economics to the venue of the event.
- At the end of the ceremony there will a farewell lunch with students and faculty.







Expenses for faculty mobility

The International Week is eligible for the Erasmus+ Teaching Mobility Fund for professors.

Visiting professor have to apply for funding directly at their home university. Coffee breaks and lunches, tickets for the Thursday visit, welcome dinner and farewell lunch will be offered by with Tor Vergata University.
