Candidates who resulted winners after this first scrolling process will have to complete the on-line enrolment procedure:

- **from July 16th to August 1st, 2019 (for EU students or NON-EU students already resident in Italy)**
- **from September 3rd to September 17th, 2019 (for NON-EU students residing abroad who need study VISA), coinciding with the time of their arrival in Italy.**

- **In case of course switch or transfer from other ITALIAN Universities**, students cannot follow the online enrolment procedure according to the mentioned deadline, since they are already enrolled in another University Program. Therefore, they will have to provide to the Students Secretary a copy that proves one of the above-mentioned requests starting **from August 1st to December 31st, 2019**. The Transfer procedure will be deeply explained in the Student Guide available starting from Summer 2019.

► **NON-EU STUDENTS RESIDING ABROAD WHO NEED STUDY VISA** that after the first merit ranking scrolling are still **eligible**, but not yet winner, will have to wait the following merit ranking scrolling. The new ranking will be published on **September 19th 2019**. The relative enrolment procedure can be accomplished starting from September 23th to October 8th 2019.

► **EU STUDENTS AND NON-EU STUDENTS ALREADY RESIDING IN ITALY**, that after the first merit ranking scrolling are still **eligible**, but not yet winner, will be inserted in the final ranking of the Second Call with their original score.

At the end of the second round of admission (reserved for EU students and NON-EU students already residing in Italy), the winner candidates will have to perform and complete the online enrolment procedure from July 16th to August 1st, 2019.

After the deadline (August 1st), the Board will keep performing the scrolling of the EU students and NON-EU students already residing in Italy merit ranking:

- If after the 31st of October 2019, deadline established by the MIUR for the assignment of the residual ranking scrolling will take positions and the related results will be published on the **6th of November 2019**. vacancies to NON-EU students that require the study VISA, there exist additional vacancies the last merit.

DETAILS FOR STUDENTS WITH A FOREIGN QUALIFICATION

International students who need study VISA for Italy, must contact the competent Italian Diplomatic Representatives in their country of residence as soon as possible in order to complete the pre-enrollment procedures within the deadline set.

All the documents released by the Italian Diplomatic Representatives are necessary to complete the enrollment procedures at University of Rome Tor Vergata. To check the list of documents and for any further information please visit our web site <http://economia.uniroma2.it/ba/business-administration-economics/pre-enrolment-procedure/>.

IMPORTANT: Foreign qualification at the time of the enrolment in any Italian University MUST be provided with the related official legalization, translation and **Declaration of Value (D.O.V.)** issued by the Italian Diplomatic Representative in the Country in which the diploma has been obtained, or with a **Statement of Comparability** issued by **CIMEA** (<http://www.cimea.it/en/index.aspx>), which is a suitable substitute for the above required documents.

For any doubt about the requirements necessary for the enrollment (which are the same for any Italian University), we encourage you to check the **Attachments 1** (http://economia.uniroma2.it/public/ba/files/Allegato1En_2_.pdf) if you have a:

- USA Qualification
 - British Qualification
 - Greek Qualifications
 - Qualifications issued by Ecclesiastical Universities located in Italy and approved by the Holy See
- and **Attachments 2** (<http://www.studiare-in-italia.it/studentistranieri/moduli/2019/allegato2.pdf>) if you have:
- Italian qualifications obtained from schools in border areas or Italian sections of foreign schools
 - International Baccalaureate Qualification



Once in Italy, all students with foreign qualification have to go to the International Students Office and provide all the required documents necessary for the enrolment at University of Rome Tor Vergata. The International Students Office will check the regularity of the documents and if they are not provided or incomplete, the admission will be invalid.
