ANNOUNCEMENT OF COMPETITION FOR THE ASSIGNMENT OF N. 4 SCHOLARSHIPS FOR STUDENTS ENROLLED AS FIRST YEAR STUDENTS IN THE MASTER'S DEGREE COURSE IN EUROPEAN ECONOMY AND BUSINESS LAW - EEBL (DEGREE CLASSIFICATION LM-90) APPROVED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMICS AND FINANCE ON 12 FEBRUARY AND SUBSEQUENTLY MODIFIED ON 14 MAY 2019.

2018/2019 ACADEMIC YEAR

Art. 1 – Purpose of the call and the available awards

In order to reward excellence and motivate academic commitment, the Department of Economics and Finance of the University of Rome Tor Vergata announces a call for applications for the 2018/2019 academic year to award of n. 4 academic prizes for students enrolled as first year students in the Master of Science Degree in European Economy and Business Law. The prizes are to be divided as follows, according to the resolution of the Department Council on 12 February 2019 and the resolution amendment of the Department Council on 14 May 2019:

- n. 1 award amounting to 1000,00 euros (before tax withholdings required by law) and n. 1 award amounting to 500,00 euros (before tax withholdings required by law) for students who enrolled as first year students in the 2017/2018 academic year and who are still regularly enrolled in EEBL or who have graduated;
- n. 1 award amounting to 1000,00 euros (before tax withholdings required by law) and n. 1 award amounting to 500,00 euros (before tax withholdings required by law) for students who enrolled as first year students in the 2018/2019 academic year and who are still regularly enrolled in EEBL.

Art.2 – Admission requirements

Students who may participate in the selection are:

- those who enrolled in the 2017-2018 academic year in their first year of study of the MSc. in *European Economy and Business Law* (degree classification LM-90) and who are still regularly enrolled in EEBL or have graduated; students will be evaluated based on the number of CFU (minimum of 60 CFU) and the grade point average achieved by 31 October 2018.
- those who enrolled in the 2018-2019 academic year in their first year of study of the MSc. in *European Economy and Business Law* (degree classification LM-90) and who are still regularly enrolled in EEBL; students will be evaluated based on the number of CFU (minimum of 60 CFU) and the grade point average achieved by 31 October 2019.

Cases for exclusion

The following candidates will be excluded from the present selection:

- Students who have previously received sanctions following the submission of false declarations aimed at obtaining benefits for the right to study or for which a disciplinary sanction has been issued.
- Students who have infringed the code of ethics or have been reported by professors or administrators as a result of inappropriate or illegal behaviour.
- All students who do not comply with the selection criteria previously indicated.

ART. 3 – Participation in the competition, selection criteria and the appointment of the commission

To participate in the selection as per this announcement, students must present a formal application, using the appropriate form attached to this announcement, which, under penalty of exclusion, must:

- present all the requested data;
- be signed by the applicant;
- be accompanied by a copy of a valid ID and an official list of exams downloaded from the Delphi online system which illustrate all exams taken during the student's academic experience in the MSc. in European Economy and Business Law.

The application for participation in the competition must be sent by email to: msc@eebl.uniroma2.it with segreteria@def.uniroma2.it in copy, by **5 November 2019**, and with the object of the email: **NAME + SURNAME + EEBl – Scholarship Application for First Year Students 2017/2018 and 2018/2019**.

By **05/11/2019**, students must be:

- in compliance with the payment of university fees and contributions for the 2017/2018 and 2018/2019 academic years (for students who enrolled as a first year student in 2017/2018);
- in compliance with the payment of university fees and contributions for the 2018/2019 academic years (for students who enrolled as a first year student in 2018/2019) and regularly enrolled in the 2019/2020 academic year;
- in possession of all the requirements described and required by Art. 2 of the present announcement and the resolution of the Department Council of 14 May 2019.

Evaluation Criteria

The evaluation of the candidates will be carried out exclusively through the evaluation of the academic curriculum, that is, by calculating the number of credits earned compared to those due and evaluating the weighted average of the grades achieved by the deadline of the public notice and indicated in the University database.



In the case of an equal ranking among candidates within the two groups, the amount of the last prize will be divided equally among those eligible. In the event that there are no students in possession of all the credits required for the exams, the prizes will not be awarded.

The selection committee will be appointed by the Department Director, with its own decree, and will be composed of three members including the recording secretary.

ART. 4 – Candidate ranking

The merit ranking, with appropriate safeguards to protect privacy, will be published on the website of the [Department of Economics and Finance](#).

The publication of the ranking will be valid in all respects as an official communication of the results. There is no other form of communication of the ranking.

The ranking will be published after 30 November 2019.
