



ANNOUNCEMENT OF COMPETITION FOR THE ASSIGNMENT OF N. 5 SCHOLARSHIPS FOR STUDENTS ENROLLED IN THE MASTER'S DEGREE COURSE IN EUROPEAN ECONOMY AND BUSINESS LAW - EEBL (DEGREE CLASSIFICATION LM-90)

2018/2019 ACADEMIC YEAR

Deadline: 31 May 2019

Art. 1 – Purpose of the call and available scholarships

In order to reward excellence, motivate academic commitment and promote participation in paid training initiatives, the Department of Economics and Finance of the University of Rome Tor Vergata announces a call for applications for the 2018/2019 academic year for the assignment of n. 5 scholarship awards for students enrolled in the Master of Science Degree Programme in European Economy and Business Law, each award amounting to € 500.00 (before tax withholdings required by law) according to the resolution of the Department Council on 12 February 2019.

Art.2 – Admission requirements

Students in the following categories may participate in the selection:

- regularly enrolled in the 2018-2019 academic year in their first year of study of the MSc. in *European Economy and Business Law* (degree classification LM-90), intending to enrol in the Dual Degree programme at SOAS University of London and in possession of the following:
 - o at least 60 CFU and all the credits required for the exams of the first year of study and/or the exams required in connection with the programme of interest at SOAS (requirement for Dual Degree). Students will be pre-evaluated based on the amount of CFU already earned, and they will be considered conditionally for the award based on whether they complete the required CFU during the 2019 summer exam session and are formally admitted into SOAS.
 - o final Bachelor degree mark of at least 104/110 (requirement for Dual Degree).
 - o IELTS average mark of 6.5, 6.5 written and spoken, 6.0 reading and listening (requirement for Dual Degree).
- regularly enrolled in the 2018-2019 academic year in their first year of study of the MSc. in *European Economy and Business Law* (degree classification LM-90), intending to participate in paid training/education at a prestigious institution and, as of 01/05/2019, in possession of:
 - o at least 24 CFU of the credits required for the exams of the first year of study;
 - o grade point average equal to or greater than 25/30.
- regularly enrolled in the 2018-2019 academic year in their second year of study of the MSc. in *European Economy and Business Law* (degree classification LM-90), intending to participate in paid



training/education at a prestigious public or private institution or company and, as of 01/05/2019, in possession of:

- at least 78 CFU of the credits required for the exams of the degree programme;
- grade point average equal to or greater than 25/30.

Cases for exclusion

The following candidates will be excluded from the present selection:

- Students who have previously received sanctions following the submission of false declarations aimed at obtaining benefits for the right to study or for which a disciplinary sanction has been issued.
- Students who have infringed the code of ethics or have been reported by professors or administrators as a result of inappropriate or illegal behaviour.
- All students who do not comply with the selection criteria previously indicated.

ART. 3 – Participation in the competition, selection criteria and the appointment of the commission

To participate in the selection as per this announcement, students must present a formal application, using the appropriate form attached to this announcement which, under penalty of exclusion, must:

- present all the requested data;
- submit the application request accompanied by a copy of a valid ID, as well as by an updated list of exams taken and weighted GPA (self-certification form);
- include details of the training/education programme (institution name, location, dates, duration, level of training, description of the programme) that students are planning to attend.

The application for participation in the competition must be sent to both of the following email addresses: msc@eebl.uniroma2.it with segreteria@def.uniroma2.it in copy, by **31 May 2019**, and with the object of the email: **NAME + SURNAME + EEBL – Scholarship Application for Educational Funding**.

By 01/05/2019, students must be:

- in compliance with the payment of university fees and contributions for the 2018/2019 academic year;
- in possession of all the requirements described and required by Art. 2 of the present announcement and the resolution of the Department Council of 12 February 2019.

The evaluation of the candidates will be carried out exclusively through the assessment of the academic curriculum, that is, by calculating the number of credits earned compared to those due and evaluating the weighted average of the grades achieved by the deadline of the public notice and indicated in the University database.

In the case of an equal ranking among candidates within the two groups, the amount of the last scholarship will be divided equally among those eligible. In the event that there are no students in possession of all the



credits required for the exams, the scholarships will be awarded among the students who have both the highest number of credits and the highest GPA.

The selection committee will be appointed by the Department Director, with its own decree, and will be composed of three members including the recording secretary.

ART. 4 – Candidate ranking

The merit ranking, with appropriate safeguards to protect privacy, will be published on the website of the [Department of Economics and Finance](#).

The publication of the ranking will be valid in all respects as an official communication of the results. There is no other form of communication of the ranking.

The ranking will be published after 10 June 2019.

ART.5 – Awarding of the prize

The awarding of the prize is subject to the successful completion of the additional training referred to in Art. 2 by 25 July 2020.
