NOTICE OF THE AWARDING OF 10 AWARDS FOR MERIT TO GRADUATES FROM THE THREE-YEAR BACHELOR DEGREE COURSE IN BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION AND ECONOMICS

A.A. 2025/2026

Deadline for submitting applications: May 5, 2026

Art. 1 – PURPOSE OF THE NOTICE AND AVAILABLE SCHOLARSHIPS

In order to reward academic excellence, an urgent call has been made for the academic year. 2025/2026 at the Department of Economics and Finance of the University of Rome Tor Vergata, for the assignment of n. 10 study awards for students GRADUATED in the three-year degree course in Business Administration and Economics. The amount of the single prize amounts to €1500.00 (before legal tax withholdings), in accordance with the resolution in the epigraph.

Art.2 – ADMISSION REQUIREMENT

Graduate who meets the following requirements can participate in the selection:

- Degree in Business Administration and Economics, obtained by the March 2026 session by students enrolled no earlier than the academic year. 2022-2023;

Cases of exclusion

The following are excluded from the selection referred to in this announcement:

- students who have previously received sanctions following the submission of false declarations aimed at obtaining benefits for the right to education or for whom a disciplinary sanction has been imposed;
- students who have broken the code of ethics;
- all those who do not comply with the previously mentioned admission requirement.

ART. 3 – PARTICIPATION IN THE COMPETITION AND APPOINTMENT OF THE COMMISSION

To participate in the selection referred to in this announcement, graduates must submit a formal application by 5 May 2026, necessarily using the appropriate form (Annex A) attached to this announcement which, under penalty of exclusion, must:

- report the requested personal data;
- be signed by the applicant;
- be accompanied by the personal data processing form (Annex B);

- be accompanied by a copy of a valid identification document as well as the list of exams taken, with weighted average, using the Delphi extract.

The application to participate in the competition must be sent exclusively using the following link

<https://forms.office.com/e/sSw8vwcThs> Otherwise the Department will not consider the application.

The Commission responsible for the selection will be appointed by the Director of the Department, with his own decree, and will be composed, in addition to the President, also of two other members including the secretary taking the minutes.

ART. 4 – AWARD CRITERIA AND MERIT RANKING

The evaluation of applications is based on the results achieved by graduates from the moment of enrollment in the three-year degree course in Business Administration and Economics until 30 April 2026.

The evaluation criteria will be as follows:

When drawing up the merit ranking, the following formula will be used:

$$\text{Score} = 50 \times \left(\frac{\text{Weighted average of exams taken}}{\text{Weighted average of exams taken by students enrolled in BA\&E}^*} \right) + 50 \left(\frac{\text{Graduation Grade}}{110} \right) + \text{award for prize}^{**}$$

* The weighted average for BA&E students is calculated considering all students enrolled independently of the year of enrollment

** The prize awarded for achieving honors in the final exam is equal to 2 points. No additional points will be awarded for any honors obtained in exams taken during the course of study.

In the case of an ex aequo position, the date of achievement of the degree title will be considered and the student who was able to obtain the degree first will prevail.

In case of a further ex aequo position, the date of the last exam will be considered and the student who was able to complete all the exams first will prevail.

In the event of a further ex-aequo position, the date of birth will be evaluated and the younger student will prevail.

The merit ranking, with the appropriate guarantees to protect privacy, will be published on the website of the Department of Economics and Finance.

The publication of the ranking will be valid in all respects as official communication of the results. No other form of communication of the ranking is foreseen.

The publication of the ranking is scheduled to start from 20 May 2026 and will continue for fourteen days.

ART. 5 – PROHIBITION OF CUMULATION

The contribution cannot be cumulated with other scholarships, prizes or other contributions granted by the University itself for the same academic year.

If the candidate is awarded another prize, scholarship or contribution for the same academic year, he or she may still participate in the selection referred to in this notice, reporting this circumstance in the application referred to in the previous article 3 and, in the event that he or she is the winner, he or she will have to exercise the right of option, returning any amount already paid by the University. A similar option, with relative refund, will be exercised in the case of another grant from the University for the same academic year, assigned after the grant referred to in this notice.
