The Intensive Training Programme provides master level students with an in-depth exposure to the way leading management consulting firms are developing digital transformation projects in order to be better prepared for a future career in management consulting. Students will have the opportunity to present their CV (both before and during the summer school) to leading consulting companies for internship opportunities. Entirely taught in English, it will be available from **July 11th to July 15th 2022**.

2. Eligibility Criteria

In order to be admitted to the selection, students must be regularly enrolled to the 2021-2022 academic year, to one of the following Schools, at the University of Rome Tor Vergata:

- School of Economics (only MSc or Laurea specialistica)
- School of Engineering (both Laurea specialistica or last year of the Laurea Triennale)

3. Selection

The selection of candidates will be based on:

- the academic performance in terms of marks and credits obtained (GPA).

In order to calculate the GPA, the Examination Board will consider the student's marks and his/her extra-activities that appear on the Delphi system on the date of the deadline for submitting applications. In case of incomplete information (i.e. the exams or extra activities are not registered yet), the students may attach a copy of their booklet (libretto) and/or possible documents issued by the University assuring the absolute completion of undertaken exams and extra-activities.

- the Curriculum vitae;
- the motivation letter.

A good knowledge of the English language (at least B2) is a requirement for a fruitful participation the programme.

There will be a ranking by school and the first 5 students from each school will be selected.

4. Application

Applications must be sent by **May 18th 2022** to managementediritto@pec.torvergata.it and in cc to digitalconsulting.yerun@mscba.uniroma2.it entering the following heading in the subject field “Intensive training programme”, and must include:

- The application form
- A copy of the identity card or passport
- Curriculum vitae
- Academic transcript (self-declaration)
- Motivation letter
- Signed G.D.P.R. Privacy Notice

One missing element will affect the applicant's eligibility.

Candidates' evaluation will be carried out by an Examination Board appointed by the School of Economics, Department of Management and Law.

WARNING: in accordance with the *art. 71 of the Presidential Decree 445/2000*, the Administration will proceed to undertake necessary checks, even sample checks, for any case showing reasonable doubts about the veracity of the statements certified by candidates on their application form.

5. Expenses

The University of Rome Tor Vergata will grant free participation to the course and will cover the accommodation in a double-room. Dinners are not included.

6. Assignment and Acceptance

The list of selected students will be published on the Management and Law Department's website in the section Call for Application (Selezioni e *Bandi*) after May 18th 2022.

PLEASE NOTE that students have 7 consecutive days from the issue of the aforementioned list to confirm their participation, by sending an e-mail to digitalconsulting.yerun@mscba.uniroma2.it.

7. Privacy Policy
