In order to be admitted to the graduation session, students may sit only the first exam in the summer session (June 3 - July 15), bearing in mind that only for those courses taught in the second semester will it be possible to take advantage of the date set in the early summer session (6-10 April and 25-29 May), subject to compliance with the exam rules of each course.

Attention, graduates for whom an extra activity is scheduled are invited to note, in block letters, in the margin of the printed degree application, all known references (activities, internships, seminars, etc. with attendance period, teacher, and date of approval).

Withdrawal from the graduation session must be communicated to the official address of the Student Secretariat (<u>segreteria-studenti@economia.uniroma2.it</u>), as soon as the cancellation has been made in Delphi, attaching a scanned copy of a valid, legible ID.

The Supervisor expresses his/her (obviously binding) decision on the work done by the graduating student, via Delphi.

It is therefore not necessary to present the assignment of the thesis, even though this document is still present within the procedure dedicated to all University programmes.

The digital review of the plan is not yet active, therefore indications provided by Delphi on any missing exams are not to be taken into account, except to verify, of course, that all exams taken are those required by your study plan in order to apply for graduation.
