



Memorandum of Understanding
between
University of Rome Tor Vergata (the Republic of Italy)
and
Capital University of Economics and Business (P.R.China)

This Memorandum of Understanding (the "MoU") establishes a formal mutually rewarding collaborative relationship and academic partnership between Capital University of Economics and Business (P.R.China, hereinafter as "CUEB") and University of Rome Tor Vergata (the Republic of Italy, hereinafter as "Tor Vergata"). This collaboration aims to foster advancement in teaching, research, academic collaboration and cultural understanding. Such cooperation may include, but not be limited to, the following areas:

- (a) exchange of scientific, academic, and technical information and appropriate academic materials and other information of mutual interest;
- (b) academic exchanges, including mutual visits of faculty and school members to pursue research and to lecture, and student exchanges on a reciprocal basis as well as joint degree programs;
- (c) identifying opportunities for exchanges and cooperation and joint research and development in disciplines of mutual interest;
- (d) organization and participation of joint academic and scientific activities such as seminars and conferences.

This Memorandum of Understanding will govern the general framework for academic cooperation and exchanges between "Tor Vergata" and "CUEB". Individual working agreements, should they arise, will be executed for specific projects under this agreement.

Each institution will appoint a liaison. The liaisons will, together, be responsible for tracking cooperative efforts, facilitating mutual assistance to the bilateral cooperation and exchanges.

This Memorandum of Understanding will become effective on the date of signature and remain effective for three years. It may be renewed for an additional term of three years by an exchange of letters between the two institutions.

This Memorandum of Understanding is signed in both English and Mandarin Chinese with equal binding effects, two copies in each. In case of differences between the English version and the Mandarin version, the first will apply. In the event of a conflict, the two institutions will resort to friendly negotiations to solve any related issues.


