3. Source of Personal Data	<p>The personal data held by the University are collected directly from the data subject.</p>
4. Purpose(s) of Personal Data handlings and Legal Basis	<p>The collected data will be processed to consent data subject to register for Refinitiv certifications, pursuant to art. 6, par. 1, lett. b), GDPR ("<i>processing is necessary for the performance of a contract to which the data subject is party or in order to take steps at the request of the data subject prior to entering into a contract</i>").</p> <p>Data Controller does not use automatic processes aimed at profiling the data subject.</p>
5. Recipients of Personal Data	<p>Within the limits pertinent to the processing purposes indicated, the data will be communicated and/or in any case accessible to the teachers of the chosen course of study, to the employees and collaborators in charge of the competent offices of the University, in their capacity as authorized subjects for processing.</p> <p>Data will be communicated to Refinitiv as company issuing the certificate(s).</p> <p>A list of Data Processor(s) can be requested by writing to mail address privacy@uniroma2.it.</p>
6. Retention time of Personal Data	<p>Students' career data will be stored for unlimited time according to the archiving purposes in the public interest, scientific or historical research purposes or statistical purposes, pursuant to articles 89 GDPR and 106 D. Lgs. 196/2003, as reformed by D. Lgs. 101/2018 ("Nuovo Codice della Privacy").</p>
7. Right(s) of the Data Subject	<p>The data subject has the right to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - ask the Data Controller (by writing to the e-mail address privacy@uniroma2.it), pursuant to articles 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20 and 21 GDPR, information and access to their personal data and the rectification or erasure of the same or the restriction of the processing that concerns them or to object to their processing, in



	addition to the right to data portability; - lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority (Garante per la Protezione dei Dati Personali, Piazza Venezia, 11, Rome, Italy, https://www.garanteprivacy.it) by writing to the e-mail address protocollo@gpdp.it or protocollo@pec.gpdp.it
8. Obligation to provide Personal Data	The data are provided on voluntary basis at the time of registration. The explicit consent or denial of consent of the Data Subject to the purpose abovementioned will be expressed after reading this information notice.
9. Processing method(s) of Personal Data	The personal data provided will be subject to processing operations in compliance with the above mentioned regulations and the confidentiality obligations that inspire the Data Controller's activities. The data will be processed both by computer and on paper and on any other suitable type of support, in compliance with the appropriate security measures pursuant to art. 5 par. 1, GDPR.
10. Transfer of Personal Data abroad	The personal data collected will be transferred to third countries, inside or outside the European Economic Area (EEA). As stated, data will be communicated to the company issuing the certificate: Refinitiv, as part of the London Stock Exchange Group, has its registered office outside the EEA. In the latter case, data transfer is necessary for the performance of a contract between the data subject and the Controller or the implementation of pre-contractual measures taken at the data subject's request, pursuant to art. 49, par. 1, lett. b) GDPR.
