2. Typology of Personal Data	<p>The University will process applicants' personal data, such as:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - name and surname; - contact details (e-mail and phone number); - residence data (Country, Area and Territory); - home university (where the applicant studied).
3. Source of Personal Data	<p>The personal data held by the University are collected directly from the data subject.</p>
4. Purpose(s) of Personal Data handlings and Legal Basis	<p>The collected data will be processed to receive, by email, promotional information about online events, webinars and similar activities related to courses of School of Economics, pursuant to art. 6, par. 1, lett. a), GDPR ("<i>the data subject has given consent to the processing of his or her personal data for one or more specific purposes</i>").</p> <p>The aforementioned events and webinars will be host on Microsoft Teams platform.</p> <p>Data Controller does not use automatic processes aimed at profiling the data subject.</p>
5. Recipients of Personal Data	<p>Within the limits pertinent to the processing purposes indicated, the data will be communicated and/or in any case accessible to the teachers of the chosen course of study, to the employees and collaborators in charge of the competent offices of the University, in their capacity as authorized subjects for processing.</p>
6. Retention time of Personal Data	<p>The data collected will be stored for a period of time not exceeding 2 years.</p>
7. Right(s) of the Data Subject	<p>The data subject has the right to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - ask the Data Controller (by writing to the e-mail address privacy@uniroma2.it), pursuant to articles 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20 and 21 GDPR, information and access to their personal data and the rectification or erasure of the same or the restriction of the processing that concerns them or to object to their processing, in addition to the right to data portability; - lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority (Garante per la Protezione dei Dati Personali, Piazza Venezia, 11, Rome, Italy,

8. Obligation to provide Personal Data	The data are provided on voluntary basis at the time of application, however are required for the provision of the services requested by applicants. The explicit consent or denial of consent of the Data Subject to the purpose abovementioned will be expressed after reading this information notice.
9. Processing method(s) of Personal Data	The personal data provided will be subject to processing operations in compliance with the above mentioned regulations and the confidentiality obligations that inspire the Data Controller's activities. The data will be processed both by computer and on paper and on any other suitable type of support, in compliance with the appropriate security measures pursuant to art. 5 par. 1, GDPR.
10. Transfer of Personal Data abroad	The personal data collected will not be transferred to third countries, inside or outside the UE.
