*¹ Regardless of the scheduling of **the first exam date**, even if it occurs after the graduation application deadline, **access is always permitted** (in this case, the graduation application must still be submitted within the established timeframe, declaring any remaining exam debts: e.g., exam “X”, with Prof. “Y”, to be taken on date “Z”).

*² Regardless of the scheduling of the **second exam date**, **access** — for the sole purpose of admission to the summer graduation session — **is strictly not permitted**.

* Documents to be submitted via email (available 24/7 at segreteria-studenti@economia.uniroma2.it), scanned in PDF format (and **not** via smartphone photos). The subject line must follow the example below, including full name, student ID number (matricola), and degree course code (M18, T18, M20, M21, T16, T17, H71, H73, H75, etc. — do not use ministerial degree class codes such as L18, L33, L16, L56, L77). The same information must be repeated in the body of the email, along with a list of the attached documents:

- **Graduation application** (downloaded from the Delphi portal), signed and then scanned in PDF format;
- **Valid personal identification document** in PDF format;
- **AlmaLaurea receipt** in PDF format.

* Regarding extracurricular activities (where applicable) and proficiency exams not yet credited on the Delphi portal, students are requested to provide all relevant details in a supplementary declaration in PDF format. (For extracurricular activities: type of activity and period of completion, and if known, the date of issuance — even if approximate — of the resolution; for proficiency exams: the course title, the date of completion, and the presiding professor).

Please note that any pending exams or extracurricular activities are listed in the supplementary declaration as they are not yet credited on Delphi, the digital platform used by students for career management.

Please keep a copy of the email sent to segreteria-studenti@economia.uniroma2.it as formal proof of the graduation application submission; the application will also appear as "active" within your personal Delphi page.

In the event of withdrawal from the graduation session, you must cancel the application on the Delphi portal and simultaneously notify both the Student Secretariat (segreteria-studenti@economia.uniroma2.it) and your Department's Teaching Office (<https://economia.uniroma2.it/segreteria-didattiche/>) via email. A scanned copy of a valid ID document must be attached, and the reason for the email must be clearly stated in the subject line.

Body: I, the undersigned Rossi Paolo, student ID 0300.000, enrolled in the M18 degree course, hereby declare my withdrawal from the ordinary graduation session scheduled for July 15, 2026. I attach a copy of a valid identification document.

For our Faculty, the final approval of the graduation thesis by the supervisor occurs via Delphi during the final thesis upload phase; therefore, the submission of a formal thesis assignment form is no longer required.

The digital verification between exams taken and the adopted study plan is not yet available (though the plan must, of course, align with the exams stipulated by the respective educational offerings). Consequently, any indications provided by Delphi regarding a non-existent digital verification, even if reported within the graduation application itself, should be disregarded.

When submitting the graduation application on the Delphi platform, please remember to enter the official course title (one of the exams from your study plan, already completed to qualify for the graduation application) and not the specific topic chosen for your thesis.

For example: "MICROECONOMICS" instead of "Equilibrium between growth and sustainability"; "LABOUR LAW" instead of "Qualification of the employment relationship"; or " ACCOUNTING AND FINANCIAL REPORTING" instead of "National principles of leasing."
