


Courses Outcome














The 70% of our graduated students are employed in Italy, and 30% moved abroad for work. The 46% of graduates chose continuing academic career. Top universities (Imperial College London, London school of Economics, LUISS, EUI) accepted our students in PhD programs. The 11% of graduates have taken positions in International Organization, such as FAO, World Bank Group. Further, the 7% of graduates work for monetary authorities, such as European Central Bank.
