Attending Students' Questionnaires

Students are involved in the answering of the questionnaires on the evaluation of the teaching quality. This is a crucial moment that has to be promoted and advertised by every instructor. The procedure is linked to the online reservation of exams. The IT system is fitted in such a way that it guarantees each questionnaire to be anonymous.

The evaluation of the teaching made by students occurs online and is valid for every course of the Programmes documented in the D.M. 509/1999 and the D.M. 270/2004. The online procedure wants to make it easier and more accessible for attending students to evaluate the teaching. The main task is to considerably increase the number of compiled questionnaires with respect to the traditional way (paper-based questionnaires).

The questionnaires on quality provide students with institutional means for expressing their opinions about the quality of teaching from different points of view. The students' opinions contribute to improve the teaching as the results of the collection of data are delivered not only to the instructor of the course, but also to the Dean of the University, and to the other agencies of the University, the Coordinator of the Programme, the Joint Commission, the Group of Re-examination and to the Evaluation Unit of the University.

Thus, the maximum participation from students is required and they have to be aware that the compiled questionnaires will be accurately analysed. The collected information will hopefully be used by each instructor and by the representatives of the teaching in order to identify strategies for improving the quality of the teaching.
