

NOTICE for REIMBURSEMENT for the completion of GRE certification 2019/2020 A.Y. – reserved for students enrolled in MSc. Economics – (in reference to the resolution from CdD DEF 10/12/2019)

GENERAL PROVISIONS

As proposed by Professor Daniela Vuri, considering that the Graduate Record Examinations (GRE) are qualifying exams required by international universities for candidates who request admission to doctoral programmes and can be used to improve students' job opportunities, the Department of Economics and Finance of Tor Vergata University of Rome, with the resolution of the Department of Economics dated 10.12.19, has allocated 8 reimbursements of up to €180,00 each for students who are regularly enrolled in the 2019/2020 academic year in MSc. Economics and who have passed the GRE exam in the period between October 2019 and October 2020, achieving a score of 160 or higher on the quantitative section. The reimbursement may be requested only once in the specified period. The reimbursements will be paid following the presentation, sent exclusively by email, of the GRE certification, which includes the candidate's name and the score achieved. The chronological order of arrival of these requests will be used to determine which candidates will be taken into consideration. Only the first 8 candidates who achieve a score of at least 160 or higher on the quantitative section within the specific period of reference will be reimbursed.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Students are eligible to present a reimbursement request if they meet the following selection criteria:

- a) They are regularly enrolled in the 2019/2020 academic year in MSc. Economics as first or second year students;
- b) They have earned GRA certification with a score of at least 160 in the quantitative section within the above-mentioned period of reference.

CASES FOR EXCLUSION

Students who have previously received sanctions following the submission of false declarations made to obtain benefits such as scholarships, or students who have received disciplinary sanctions, will be excluded from the prize referred to in the present announcement.

PRESENTATION OF THE REQUEST FOR RIEUMBURSEMENT

In order to be considered, students must present a formal request form (**GRE Reimbursement Request Form**) between **1 January 2020 and 31 December 2020**. The form must be completely filled in and signed by the student and sent by email to **both of the following email addresses: segreteria@def.uniroma2.it** and **msc_economics@economia.uniroma2.it**, specifying in the object of the message "NAME+SURNAME+GRE Student Prize".

The request form must be sent with the following attachments:

- Copy of valid ID
- Copy of Italian tax ID number (*codice fiscale*)
- Copy of GRE certification which includes the date of exam, score, student name
