Course Description

LATEX is a document preparation system, mainly used in academics to write articles, books, CVs and presentations. The objective of the course is to provide students with the basic tools to write a document, including figures, tables and references, and a presentation using Beamer. Classes will be interactive.

Installing LATEX

To use LATEX on their computer, students will need to download one or more softwares. The recommended software for typesetting documents with LATEX is MiKTeX. Students can find all the steps required to install MiKTeX at this link: https://miktex.org/download.

Course Structure

The course is structured in three classes:

- 1. The basics: setting up a LATEX document, typesetting text and equations;
- 2. How to structure a document: sections, figures and tables, bibliography;
- 3. How to present with LATEX: Beamer.
