3. Job description: "_Statistical analysis of firm-level microdata from WWII and post-war Bordeaux"

- The objective of this research project is to shed light on how the expropriation of Jewish firms in WWII Bordeaux affected the local market structure during the war and how persistent the changes were, providing evidence on the old debate whether markets correct themselves or whether market power is persistent.
- The intern will be involved in both the organization, analysis and potentially collection of some additional data.
- The intern will develop the following skills: econometric analysis, data cleaning and organizing, reducing complex questions to testable hypotheses and economic models that can be taken to the data. This will be tailored based on the intern's skills and interests.
