3. Job description: “Mapping the Scientific Research Network in Italy”

- The project aims to explore the research network within Italian academia, focusing on its structure and distinctive features. Specifically, it seeks to identify any unique patterns or characteristics in the connections among Italian universities across the country.
- The analysis will examine potential geographical disparities, such as differences between northern and southern regions or between metropolitan and suburban institutions. Furthermore, the project will investigate gender dynamics within this network, with particular attention to women's participation and connectivity.
- The data for this project come from two main sources: information on PRIN projects from 1997 to year 2020 and co-authorship data, derived from Scopus, for all tenured faculty members in Italy.
- The intern will be involved in analyzing data and network constructing
- The intern will develop the following skills: handling, organizing, analyzing, and processing data, as well as gaining experience with data analysis tasks that require a level of depth and rigor typical of scientific research.
