3. *Job description: "Interest Rates, Banks and Financial Stability"*

- The objective of this research project is to examine how interest rates influence banks and other financial intermediaries, and how these effects are subsequently transmitted to firms and households. A key component of the analysis may involve the use of rich matched firm-bank data, to study the micro-level mechanisms behind the transmission of interest-rate changes to the real economy.
- The intern will be involved in collecting and analyzing bank-level data and monetary shocks, with the opportunity to contribute via coding or code checking in Stata (or R). The intern will potentially also be involved in theoretical work, complemented with simple coding in MATLAB or Julia.
- The intern will develop the following skills: improved data management skills, improved Stata or R coding for data analysis. Developed theoretical skills and improved the ability to write code in MATLAB or Julia.

Please note: The student must complete 150 internship hours over the course of at least three months and submit the Tutor's final evaluation document, questionnaires and timesheet at least 45 days prior to his/her graduation.
