The **Master of Science Degree in European Economy and Business Law** (MSc EEBL), with a ministerial degree classification of **LM-90 in European Studies**, is geared toward students who are interested in acquiring more knowledge regarding the economic and legal aspects of the process of European integration. The programme is taught entirely in English over a period of two years and begins with a review of statistics, mathematics, micro and macroeconomics. Students integrate their core academic experience by participating in events and moments of exchange with professionals from various sectors. Moreover, during their studies, students may carry out a training activity in Italy or abroad that can be a curricular internship of at least three months or another activity aimed at acquiring additional skills useful for entrance into the workforce. This multidisciplinary degree programme provides useful training in areas such as soft skills and computer programs that enable students to hone their analytical skills, develop problem-solving skills and apply their acquired expertise in an international context.
