KPMG Innovation & Collaboration Challenge 2019

The selection process is open for those wishing to participate in the **KPMG Innovation & Collaboration Challenge** (KICC), an international competition that will challenge teams from 25 countries around the world. The KICC represents an opportunity to try to solve some of the main challenges on the planet; participants will undertake a new formative journey, explore new ways of thinking and conceiving teamwork, and experience first-hand what it will mean to be a professional in the future.

The Italian competition is organised in stages, therefore the **Road to KICC** includes several initiatives and will conclude with the participation of the winning team at the international finale in **Buenos Aires, Argentina**.

The goal is to use strategic, creative business and global skills to propose an idea that meets the following need:

What innovations would help people in disadvantaged communities in your country to take control of their health and well-being?

How to participate in the Road to KICC?

Apply to participate in one of the five **KICC Bootcamps organised in Italy**:

Rome - 5 November 2018 (deadline 29 October)
Milan - 13 November 2018 (deadline 6 November)
Bologna - 16 November 2018 (deadline 9 November)
Padua - 23 November 2018 (deadline 16 November)
Turin - 28 November 2018 (deadline 21 November)

You can apply for Bootcamps alone or in a group, together with up to three other people. All the people on your team must send their application, respecting the required prerequisites and indicating on their CV the names of the other members of the group. Individual applications or groups of less than four people will be grouped with other participants.

What do you need in order to participate in the Road to KICC?

- You must be enrolled in a Bachelor's or Master's Degree in Economics or STEM (Engineering, Computer Science, Mathematics, Physics or Statistics)
- You must be able to communicate fluently in English
- You must be an enthusiastic, creative and innovative person who likes teamwork!
