\*\*Tor Vergata students unable to complete 54CFU before departure may still be considered for participation in the programme. Students who complete a minimum of 48 CFU of core courses and an extra activity in their first year of study at Tor Vergata may request the permission from the EEBL Coordinator to participate in the dual title programme. If permission is granted, students may subsequently request credit recognition for a SOAS course in correspondence to an elective course at Tor Vergata, for a total of 72 CFU in their second year of study.

\*\*\*SOAS students must present an original final thesis/dissertation at SOAS the first year and at Tor Vergata at the end of the second year of study.
