ANNOUNCEMENT OF COMPETITION FOR THE ASSIGNMENT OF N. 2 REIMBURSEMENTS FOR STUDENTS REGULARLY ENROLLED IN THE 2023-2024 ACADEMIC YEAR IN THE MASTER OF SCIENCE IN EUROPEAN ECONOMY AND BUSINESS LAW - EEBL (DEGREE CLASSIFICATION LM-90)

(In accordance with the May 14, 2024
resolution N. 7.1 of the Department of Economics and Finance Council)

2023/2024 ACADEMIC YEAR

Deadline: June 30, 2024

Art. 1 – Purpose of the call and the available awards

In order to reward excellence and motivate academic commitment, the Department of Economics and Finance of the University of Rome Tor Vergata announces a call for applications for the 2023/2024 academic year to award n. 2 reimbursement of up to €600,00 each for students regularly enrolled in MSc European Economy and Business Law in the 2023/2024 academic year (in accordance with the May 14, 2024 resolution of the Department of Economics and Finance) who present a learning project such as, for example, a summer school, internship or professional training activity that is aligned with the learning objectives of the EEBL academic program.

Art.2 – Application requirements for candidates

Students may participate in the selection if they are regularly enrolled in MSc European Economy and Business Law (LM-90 degree classification) in the 2023/2024 academic year.

Cases for exclusion

The following candidates will be excluded from the present selection:

- Students who have previously received sanctions following the submission of false declarations aimed at obtaining benefits for the right to study or for which a disciplinary sanction has been issued.
- Students who have infringed the code of ethics, behaved inappropriately or committed illegal acts.
- All students who do not comply with the selection criteria previously indicated.

ART. 3 – Participation in the competition, and the nomination of the evaluation committee

To participate in the selection as per this announcement, students must present a formal application by **June 30, 2024**, by using the appropriate form attached to this announcement (**Annex A**), which, under penalty of exclusion, must:

- contain all requested personal and fiscal information;
- be signed by the applicant;
- be accompanied by a declaration of enrolment in MSc European Economy and Business Law (**Annex B**);
- be accompanied by the privacy policy, signed and dated (**Annex C**);
- be accompanied by a copy of a valid ID and an official list of exams downloaded from the Delphi online system.



The application for participation in the competition must be sent to both of the following email addresses: msc@eebl.uniroma2.it and segreteria@def.uniroma2.it, and with the object of the email: **NAME + SURNAME + EEBL Project Prize Application – Decree N. 28/2024**. Otherwise, the Department reserves the right to not take the application into consideration.

The Selection Committee will be appointed by Decree of the Director of the Department, and will be composed of the President and two other members, including the secretary.

Conditions for the awarding of the prize

The payment of the reimbursement is subject to the submission of documentation regarding the proven payment of any project fees and the actual completion of the project; if by December 31, 2024, the winning student has not met the above requirements, the award will pass to the first eligible student in the ranking.

ART. 4 – Candidate evaluation and merit ranking

The evaluation of applications is based on the quality of the proposed project (50%) and the student's academic career (50%) which includes the student's achievements from the year of enrolment in the Master's Degree Program in European Economy and Business Law until the winter examination session of the academic year 2023/2024. In evaluating the candidates' academic careers, the score awarded will also take into account factors such as grade point average, number of credits earned and year of first enrolment.

Only exams taken at the University of Rome Tor Vergata and taken abroad as part of mobility programs will be considered. For students who have transferred from another university or another study program of this university, the commission will not take into account the recognition of the achieved credits that were earned before the time of the transfer.

In the case of an equal ranking the age of the candidates will be taken into consideration and the prize will be awarded to the younger candidate.

In the event that a number of scholarships remain unassigned, there will be no new selection.

The merit ranking will be published on the website of the Department of Economics and Finance (<https://economia.uniroma2.it/def/selezioni-bandi/>). The publication of the ranking will be valid in all respects as an official communication of the results. There is no other form of communication of the ranking.

The ranking is expected to be published online from July 15, 2024, for a duration of fourteen days.

ART. 5 – Prize accumulation policy notice

The monetary prize of the scholarship cannot be awarded if other scholarships, prizes or incentives have been granted by the University during the same academic year 2023/2024. If the student is already the recipient of another award for the same academic year referred to in this announcement, he/she may send an application to participate in the present selection, indicating the circumstances by using the application form mentioned in Art. 3; in the case that he/she is a winner of two merit scholarships, the student must choose the scholarship that will be kept and return the funds that have already been paid by the University. Similarly, the scholarship funds should be returned if the student becomes recipient of another scholarship after the awarding of the present scholarship.



Such options must be communicated by sending notification to both of the following email addresses: msc@eebluniroma2.it and segreteria@def.uniroma2.it, specifying which scholarship prize he/she intends to keep.

ART.6 – Processing of personal data
