Research Assistant in the Department of Economics and Finance on the research project: "Gender Effects on Bargaining and Economic Behavior"

2. Skills and Experience required

- Languages required: English

- Skills required: knowledge of the Stata software (basic); some experience in management of micro-data; good knowledge of statistics.

3. Job description: "Gender and Decision-Making"

- The objective of this research project is to investigate the relationship between economic decision-making, gender and gender discrimination. It draws on diverse data sources, ranging from surveys to experiments, to deepen the understanding of well-documented gender differences in economically relevant characteristics and behaviours (e.g., bargaining, preferences for risk, health). It also explores how economic behaviour and outcomes vary depending on the gender composition in strategic settings.
- The intern will be involved in managing and statistically analysing the data that has already been collected via an online experiment. They will also contribute to the review of the relevant literature. Depending on the timing of the internship, they may also be involved in managing a new data collection.
- The intern will develop the following skills: strengthening their coding skills in Stata; producing statistical analyses aimed at (i) answering specific research hypotheses, and (ii) laying the groundwork for regression analysis; identifying reliable and robust evidence from the existing literature.
