Brief Description	<p>The School of Economics of the University of Rome "Tor Vergata" is located in a complex of two symmetrical, modern and functional buildings in Via Columbia, 2, 00133 Roma.</p> <p>Building "A", houses 36 classrooms, the degree Thesis presentation room, a large auditorium with a seating capacity of 450 people, four student reading rooms and the computer room for Erasmus students. There are also two bars and a canteen where the food service for student card holders is offered, a student information centre, and a doorman security service, two computer rooms, a language lab.</p> <p>Building "B", where the Erasmus Office is located, contains the departmental offices, the professors' offices, where they meet the students, the masters' classes, the library, the meeting rooms, the Faculty Senate Chamber and a cafeteria.</p>

Cost of living

The minimum costs of living for a student is approximately € 1000 per month. This includes food and personal care, housing, books, public transport and free time. This is just to give you an idea of average monthly expenses, but it depends on your personal standards and requirements.

Accommodation: Student House, rooms in private homes, shared apartments with other students. The cost is approximately € 400/500 per month. Metro/ bus card € 35 per month.

Transfers

From Airport to Roma Termini station (city centre)

From Roma Fiumicino Airport (Leonardo Da Vinci airport): there are both the train and the bus;

From Roma Ciampino Airport: there are both the train (with a change in Ciampino station) and the bus.

From centre to University

Metro A (direction to Anagnina): from Roma Termini station to Anagnina. Then take the bus number 20 till Cambridge stop

On public transport:

- **Underground Metro A + Bus:** Linea A to end of line ANAGNINA stop, then take bus #20 (express line) or bus #500 from underground stop to the Faculty of Economics
- **Bus:** Bus #105 or # 157 from via Casilina
- **Train + Bus:** Roma-Pantano (Casilino) - TORRENOVA stop then take bus #507 or #105
- **Coach line ATRAL:** Ciampino Train Station to Università di Tor Vergata
