Who is eligible for the Erasmus+ scholarship?



- All the students regularly enrolled at the School of Economics 2020-2021, starting from the first year of both bachelor and master courses;
- The language certificate with the level is mandatory in order to apply.
- The level for students attending a degree course entirely taught in English is B2.







Necessary documents

- I.D. or Passport number (valid for the duration of the semester of study abroad);
- IBAN (your own personal bank account number);
- Bachelor diploma and/or «dichiarazione di valore» (only for foreign students);
- Language certificate/self-declaration.





Which language certificate is necessary to apply?



- A certificate of proficiency is <u>mandatory</u> in order to fill in the online form;
- Each partner university has its own language requirement, that heve to be respected and can be viewed at the following link:

Which is the duration of the Erasmus+ period?



 In order to receive the scholarship, the duration of the Erasmus+ program is of a minimum of 2 months in presence up to a maximum of 12 months (for both bachelor and master courses) per study cycle.





How much is the Erasmus+ scholarship?



- The contribution for the Erasmus+ scholarship is not yet confirmed by the National Agency but approximatly is € 300 per month.
- The 70% of the scholarship will be distributed only after the arrival at the Host Institution.
- The remaining 30% will be paid upon the student return.

Indicatively the departures are:

First Semester (Fall semester)

from August 2021

Second Semester (Spring semester)

from January 2022





Which are the criteria for the evaluation of the ranking?



- The criteria that will be used for the ranking are: exams (to be counted until October, 15° 2020), weighted average, first year of enrollment;
- In the final ranking, bachelor and master students will be merged, according to the number of applications received;
- As for PhD students the Erasmus+ Academic Committee will evaluate the CV.







After filling in the online form

1st step: publishing of the ranking (first week of May);

2nd step: the presentations of the Partner Universities can be viewed online;

3rd step: allocation of the Erasmus+ grants online on the 10 and 11 of May.

4th step: Students will also sign online the preliminary acceptance contract;

5th step: Departure.

Students who don't participate to the online meetings will be considered as renouncers.

Dates as for the different meetings on May will be communicated by email.









- The fees must be paid only at the Home University;
- Students are asked to contact their Program Office
 (Segreteria Didattica) which will provide all the
 information as regards the procedures to be followed
 for the approval of courses to be attended while abroad.





Which are the requirements to obtain the Erasmus+ scholarship?

To obtain the Erasmus+ Scholarship it's necessary to obtain a minimum number of credits:

- 6 ECTS for a trimester;
- 12 ECTS for a semester;
- 24 ECTS for a year.
