10 Steps of the Incoming Exchange Program Process

1. Presentation to the Coordinator of our Partner Universities & Pre-Arrival presentations
2. Reception of nominations by forms (see infosheet on our website)
3. Reception of applications by the Incoming Exchange application portal (see infosheet on our website)
4. Delivery of the acceptance or rejection letter
5. Delivery of the modules and courses list, and reception of the selections of the students
6. Control and signature of learning agreement & certificates
7. Organization of Incoming Exchange Students Events
8. Elaboration of the Transcript of Records together with Examination Office (for download on CampusNet/AC5)

Accommodation

Living costs in Berlin & Hamburg


- € 500 to € 700 /month – room in shared flat (2 to 4 people)
- € 800 to € 1000 /month – single apartment

Living costs in Dresden

- € 300 to € 400 /month – room in shared flat (2 to 4 people)
- € 400 to € 600 /month – single apartment

Depending on the offer, the following costs should be counted in addition:

- Electricity (approx. € 30 per month for 1 person)
- TV / Internet+Wifi (approx. € 30 per month)
- Broadcasting fee ("Rundfunkgebühren") for every household, not per person (approx. 18,36 € per month for a household)



→ **Tip:** to find cheaper rooms search at neighborhoods farther from the center, but close to a subway, tram or bus station.
