Health insurance	Students must have a health insurance which is valid in Switzerland. <u>EU/EFTA</u>: European Health Insurance Card, EHIC. <u>Non-EU students</u>: Proof of health insurance valid in Switzerland * Health insurance provider in home country signs an exemption form together with a copy of the insurance policy in English, both documents will be evaluated by the local authorities in St.Gallen. If the documents are not accepted by the local authorities, students are obliged to sign up for a Swiss health insurance (approx. CHF 90.00 / month). * Please note: The insurance policy has to explicitly and clearly state that the coverage is unlimited. Otherwise it won't be accepted in Switzerland.
