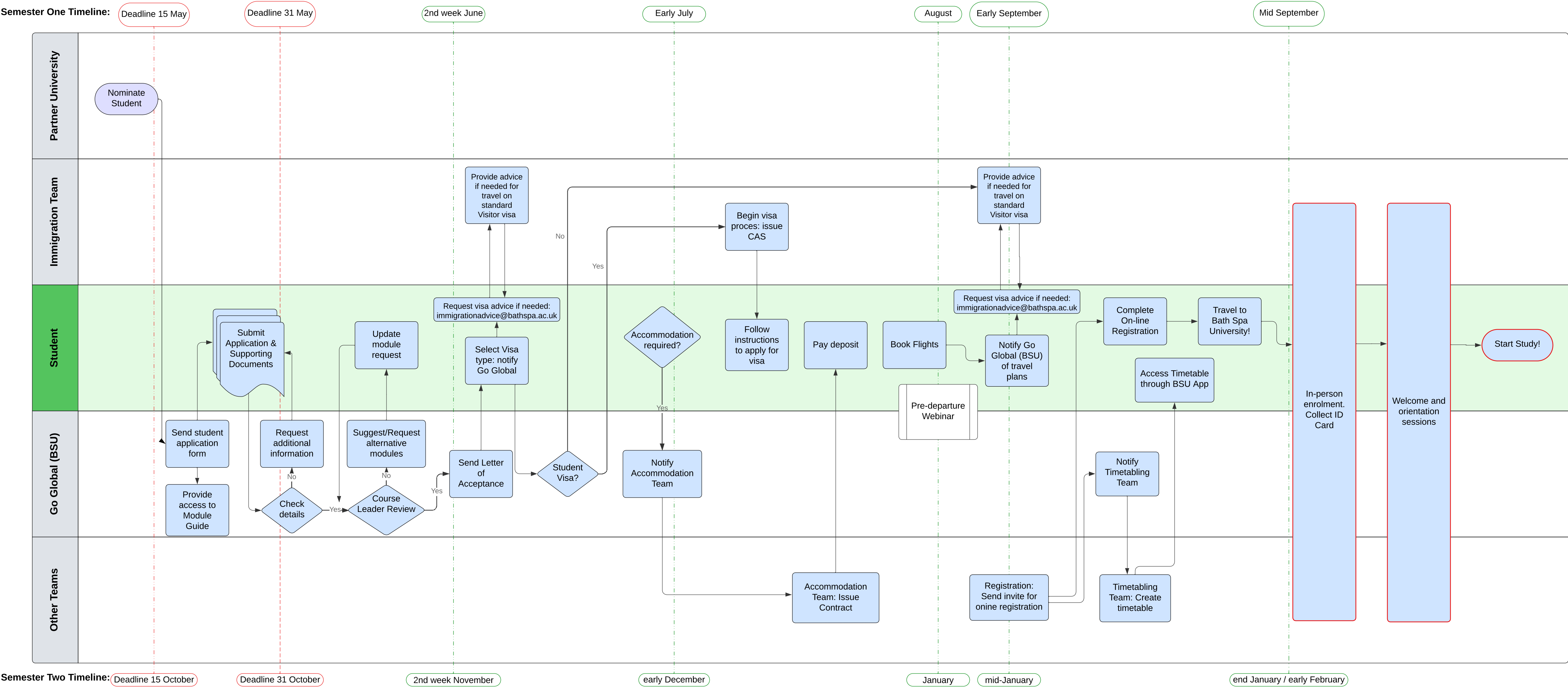


Semester Abroad: Inbound Exchange Process to BSU: Go Global



Deadlines:

Semester One:
Nomination Deadline - 15 May
Application Deadline - 31 May

Semester Two:
Nomination Deadline - 15 October
Application Deadline - 31 October

Supporting Documents:

- Completed application form
- Module request form
- An academic transcript, which documents your previous studies at the home university
- Evidence of your English Language proficiency. Unless a national of a majority English speaking country, you need to submit an English language qualification. All teaching at Bath Spa University is in English and students are expected to have the equivalent of CEFR B2 level in English. Details of required evidence can be found here: <https://www.bathspa.ac.uk/how-to-apply/international/english-language-requirements/>. Students coming for a single semester and travelling on a standard Visitor Visa may provide a Letter of Attestation from the home university.
- Colour photocopy of the passport identification page
- Portfolio, if required (for modules with the from Bath School of Art, Film and Media or the Bath School of Design)

Module Selection:

Students will be provided access to the Module Guides upon nomination.
As a visiting exchange student, students have the flexibility to select modules from across the levels and from different degree programmes making a total of 60 BSU Credits for a single semester. Our dedicated Timetabling Team will create a bespoke timetable once enrolment is completed. To allow for potential timetable clashes, we ask students to provide a list of 5-10 modules which they would be interested in taking. In all cases, the modules requested at Bath Spa University must be approved by the home university.
