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## How to choose courses (1/4)

### **Course selection rules**

- You must register 30 credits per semester
- Each semester is divided into four (4) periods (ca.5 weeks/per period).
- You must take one course in a period and meet the entry requirement.
- You can take "Swedish for International students 1, 2 or 3" on the top of full-time study load (up to two courses).
- It is possible to take course from different subject areas (e.g., Business Studies and Economics).
- Students at master's level can choose courses from both bachelor's and master's level.
