REQUIREMENTS TO APPLY FOR AN EXCHANGE AT UM

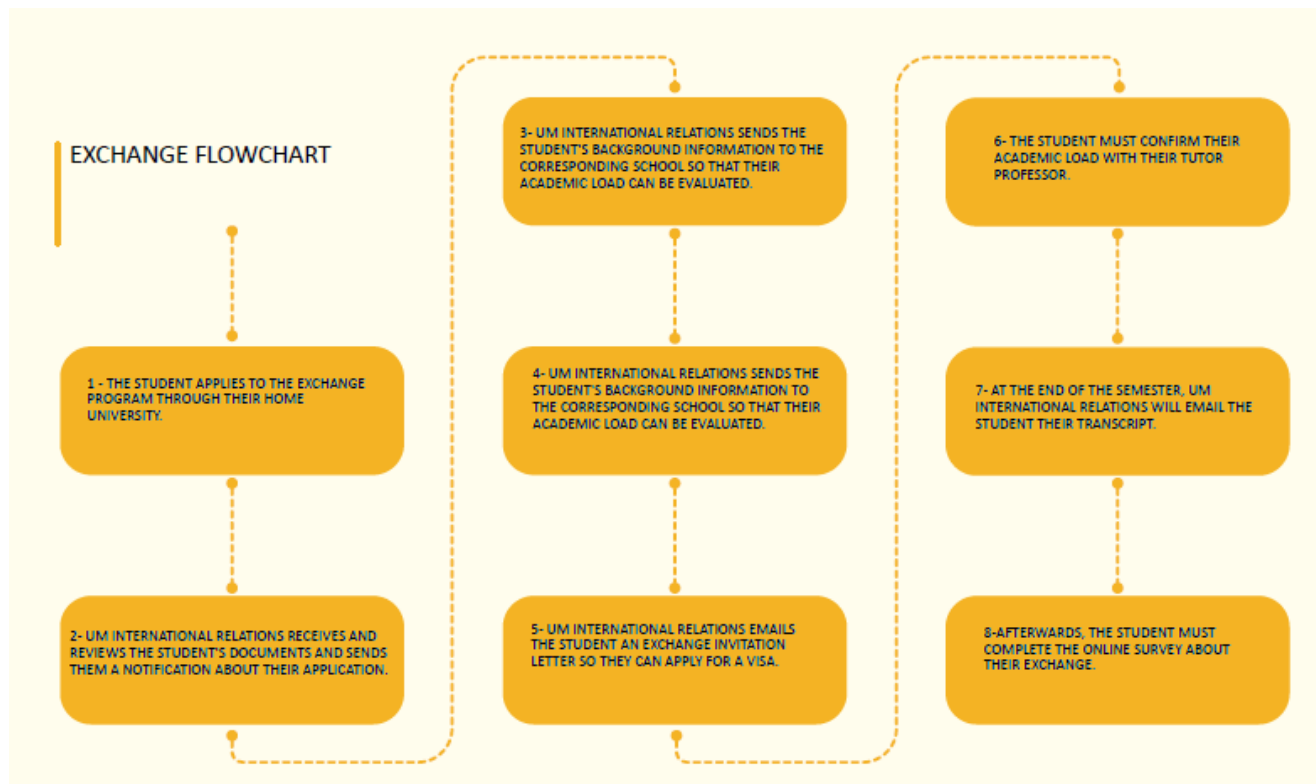


1. Be a regular student at your home university and have authorization from the International Relations Office to participate in an exchange abroad.



2. Complete and submit your application through the international relations office at your home university.

APPLICATION PROCESS FOR INCOMING INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS



DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR APPLICATION

- ✓ UM application form
- ✓ Copy of passport valid for at least six months after the end of the exchange
- ✓ Letter of nomination signed by the person in charge and stamped by the International Relations Office of the home university
- ✓ Official academic transcript from the home university
- ✓ Spanish language certificate equivalent to level B.2 (620 to 675 teaching hours), in accordance with the CEFR
- ✓ Copy of medical insurance in English or Spanish
- ✓ Passport-style colour photograph with a white background, JPG format (enrolment)
- ✓ Architecture degree: students must submit their portfolio
- ✓ Current vaccination records, if applicable to health-related degrees
- ✓ Exchange fee: Each student must pay Universidad Mayor the equivalent in Chilean pesos of US\$60 once they have been accepted to participate in the student mobility programme. This amount is attributed to the exchange management and administration of the International Relations Office. If the student does not participate in the exchange, this amount will not be refunded.

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED PRIOR TO ARRIVAL IN CHILE

➤ Airline tickets

➤ International health insurance, which must provide coverage for the entire duration of your stay in Chile. It must include:

- Medical expenses for at least USD \$30,000
- Funeral and medical repatriation



IMPORTANT INFORMATION

PERMITS FOR ENTRY INTO CHILE

To enter Chile for less than 180 days, a Temporary Stay Permit is required. This permit can be obtained upon arrival at the airport in Santiago, at the International Police station. The permit is issued for a maximum of 90 days and can be renewed for another 90 days (only once). This renewal costs USD \$100. [MORE DETAILS](#).
