



### ORIENTATION, EXCURSIONS & STUDENT ASSOCIATION

The International Affairs Office organizes a student orientation the first week of students' arrival. This includes getting students acclimated to the French business school structure, French language courses, and the French culture. In the first month of the students' arrival, the International Affairs Office takes exchange students on an excursion in the Paris area to a cultural area.
