Academic Calendar	The Fall Semester starts the first week of September until the end of December. <i>Please notice, that exceptionally some exams could take place in January 2026.</i> The Spring Semester starts the first week of January until the end of June. No second-chance exams for Master's students. Bachelor's: second session in July. Transcripts are sent by email once all grades are in: by March (Fall) / July (Spring).

Number of credits and grading system	Undergraduate and graduate : 30 ECTS/semester, 60 ECTS/Year - Bachelor's degrees : 3 years, 180 ECTS - Master's degrees : 1 year = 60 ECTS, 2 years = 120 ECTS
