Spanish B2 level required for TRAINEESHIPS in Dentistry, Medicine, Nutrition, Physiotherapy & Podiatry. English B1 level if you will follow courses taught in English. English B2 level required for Business & Marine Sciences degree. A Passport sized picture (for your student's card) Criminal Record Certificate -in Spanish, English or validated by your Home University- (required for all the Traineeship's exchanges from Education degrees, Medicine, Nursing, Occupational Therapy, Speech Therapy, Psychology, Podiatry, Physiotherapy, Sports Sciences and for all the incoming in Dentistry-studies and traineeship's).
